Parental Responsibility

To fulfil our legal obligations we need to have an accurate record of those people who legally hold Parental Responsibility for the children of this school.

Who has Parental Responsibility

In England and Wales, if the parents of a child are married to each other at the time of the birth, or if they have jointly adopted a child, then they both have parental responsibility. Parents do not lose parental responsibility if they divorce, and this applies to both the resident and non-resident parent. This is not automatically the case for unmarried parents. According to current law, a mother always has parental responsibility for her child. A father, however has this responsibility only if he is married to mother when the child is born or has acquired legal responsibility for his child through one of these three routes:

- From 1st December 2003 by jointly registering the birth of the child with the mother (Father's name appears on the Birth Certificate)
- By parental responsibility agreement with the mother
- By parental responsibility order, made by a court

Living with the mother, even for a long time, **does not** give a father parental responsibility.
